

# 2009 OAA Auxiliary Scholarship Application

*The OAA Auxiliary will award two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each. The OAA Auxiliary Scholarship Committee will select the recipients from a pool of qualified applicants. Candidates scholastic merit, as well as overall extracurricular involvements, will be considered. Any questions concerning the application process should be addressed to the committee chair listed below.*

## 1. Who is Eligible?

- A relative of an active OAA Member in good standing for a period of two years. An active member means s/he should attend OAA conventions (minimum of two consecutive conventions) and be active in the auction profession.
- Applicants must be graduating from an accredited high school and have been accepted into a qualified college, university, or school of higher education; or applicants must have completed the past year at a qualified college, university, or school of higher education.
- There is no limit to how many times a candidate may apply for the award, but may only receive the scholarship once.
