The Ohio Auctioneers Foundation awards two scholarships in the amount of \$1,000.00 each annually. The Ohio Auctioneers Foundation Scholarship Committee will select the recipients from a pool of qualified applicants. Candidates scholastic merit, as well as overall extracurricular involvements, will be considered. Deadline for submission is **DECEMBER 1**.

Who is Eligible?

- Although this application is open to all Ohio school students, the preference will be that the student is a dependent child or grandchild of an active Ohio Auctioneer Association member who is in good standing with the Association. This scholarship is a one (1) year scholarship. All candidates may reapply each year that they are eligible.
- Applicants must be graduating from an accredited high school and have been accepted into a qualified college, university, or school of higher education; or applicants must have completed the past year at a qualified college, university or school of higher education.
